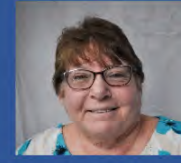

## Information to Know

Thank you for a wonderful 2024 in Cedar Lake and we look forward to serving our Cedar Lake Community in 2025!

In 2025, we look forward to breaking ground on the Shades Phase 2 Project in the Spring. The Town will be using funds awarded to us through the Community Crossings Matching Grant. This phase of construction will include additional roadway improvements, installing curbs, and stormwater additions.

The Council looks forward to a road raise and the installation of a new culvert near Lemon Lake County Park. We hope to begin this project in the late summer/early fall of 2025.

The Town was also recently awarded \$171,000 from the INDOT Safety Funds through the Highway Safety Improvement Program for signage on Lake Shore Drive and Hilltop Street and also for rumble strip installation on Parrish Avenue.

The Town is currently working on securing additional funds for additional projects for 2025. Please stay tuned for more upcoming projects in 2025!

## From the Desk of Jeff Bunge, Town Manager

Hello and Happy 2025 to you All,

As we put 2024 in the rearview mirror, I would like to point out a few of the Town's accomplishments from the year.

Firstly, the Town completed a large portion of improvements along 133<sup>rd</sup> Avenue roadway from Morse Street to the Towns' eastern boundary line, which included asphalt sealing and thermoplastic road striping.

Shades Phase 1 was completed and included replacing roadways and installing curbs and stormwater facilities. This was a very large project and we are excited to begin Phase 2.

This past summer, Lynnsway Subdivision was upgraded with an ADA compliant sidewalk and at-grade ramps, which were paid for with Block Grant Funding.

Construction on the new Public Works Building is nearing completion.

It has been a busy 2024, and we look forward to more improvements on the horizon for 2025!

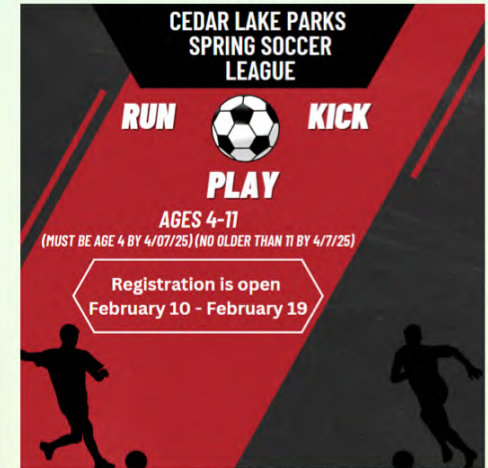
