

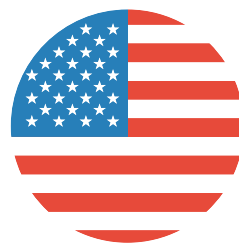

Register your out of State Vehicles
For residents of the Town of Cedar Lake who are new to Indiana, state law requires that you transfer your out-of-state vehicle title and registration to the Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) within 60 days of establishing residency. To complete the process, please visit your local BMV branch. The Cedar Lake Police Department is actively enforcing this state law.

A Word from the Chiefs

FIREWORKS TOWN ORDINANCE (102.03)

DAYS OF USE: June 29, 30th / July 1,2,3,5,6,7,8,9th
TIME OF USE: Between 5:00 p.m. and two hours after sunset (11 p.m.)

July 4th from 10 a.m. to 12:00 midnight

Fireworks can only be used on property owned by person or with permission and by someone over age of 18 yrs unless with parent.

Consumer Fireworks:

Types of 1.4 fireworks (previously known as “Class C”)
- Consumer = certain types of 1.4G fireworks (bottle rockets, roman candles, and fire crackers)
- Sec. 8(a) = sparklers, ground spinners, cone fountains, wheels, cylindrical fountains
- Special fireworks = 1.3G fireworks for which a permit from the U.S. Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives shall be obtained prior to purchase, storage, or use.
